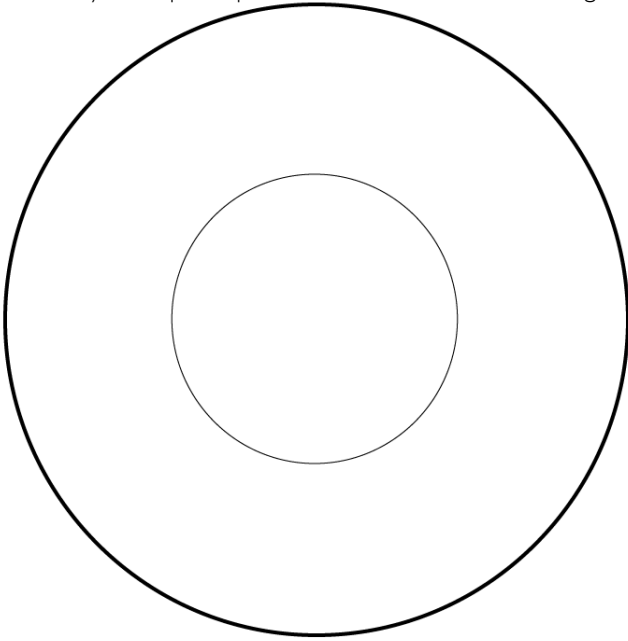
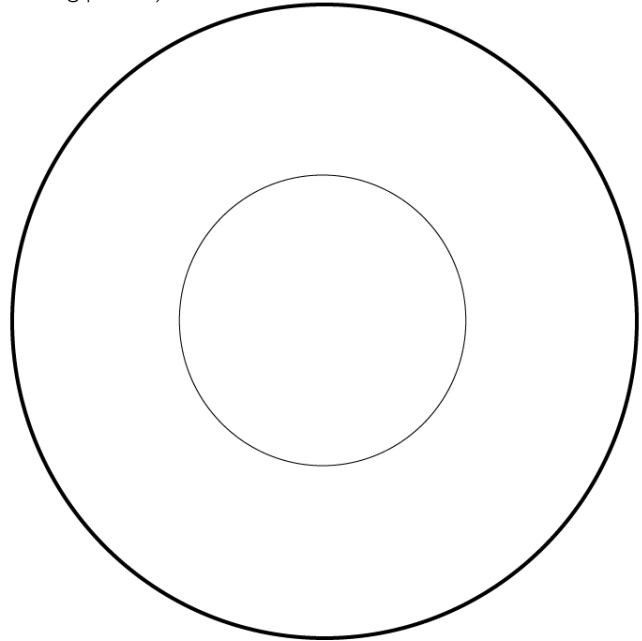


Ceramics Planning Sheet part 2

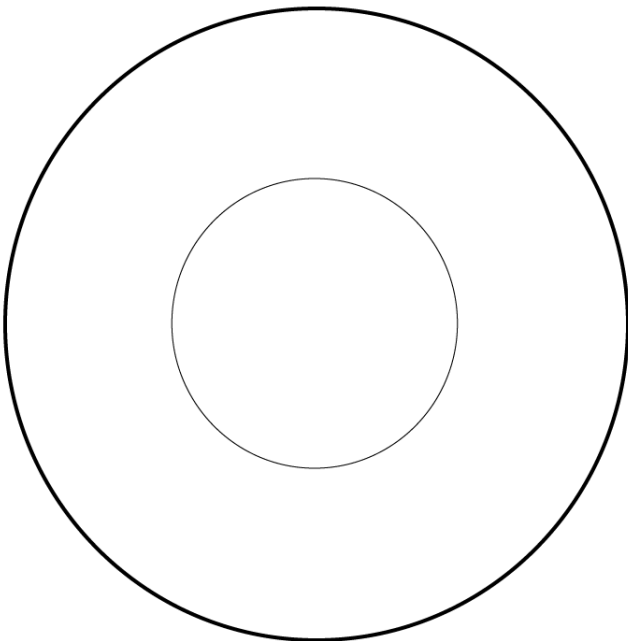

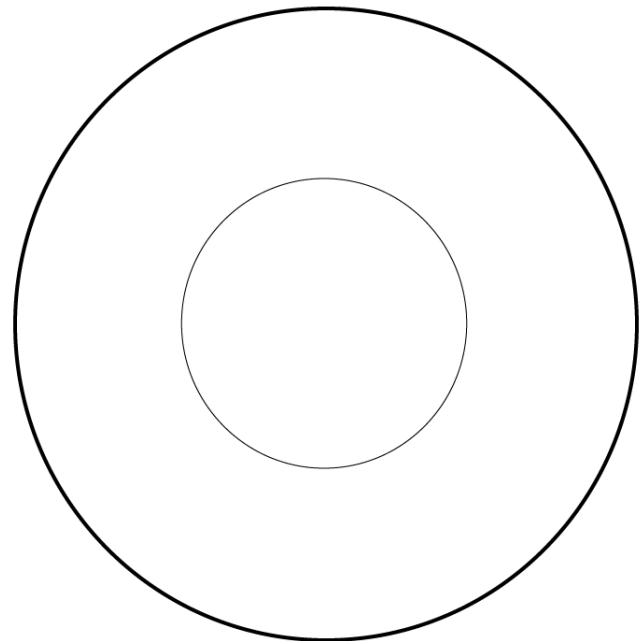
